This section contains the Equipment Rental Costs Per acre rate: Equipment rental or custom rates are based upon the addition of all yearly costs divided by the estimated annual hours of use. The hourly rate (\$/hr) divided by the work rate (acre/hr) yields a cost per acre rate. The work rate accounts for equipment width, travel speed and the field efficiency of the operation.
