



Postdoctoral Appointee sought by Argonne National Laboratory

The Environmental Science Division of Argonne National Laboratory, located 25 miles southwest of Chicago, Illinois, is seeking a postdoctoral candidate with a Ph.D. with an emphasis on the effects of instream flows on aquatic organisms and their habitats.

The candidate would compile and analyze information pertinent to evaluating the effects of hydropower operations on downstream aquatic organisms and habitats. Candidates should have knowledge of and/or research experience in one or more of the following areas: aquatic ecology, instream flow and habitat evaluation, population estimation techniques, and the effects of habitat alterations on animal populations. A strong background in statistical analyses is desired and modeling experience would be beneficial. The position is for one year, but is potentially renewable for up to three years.
